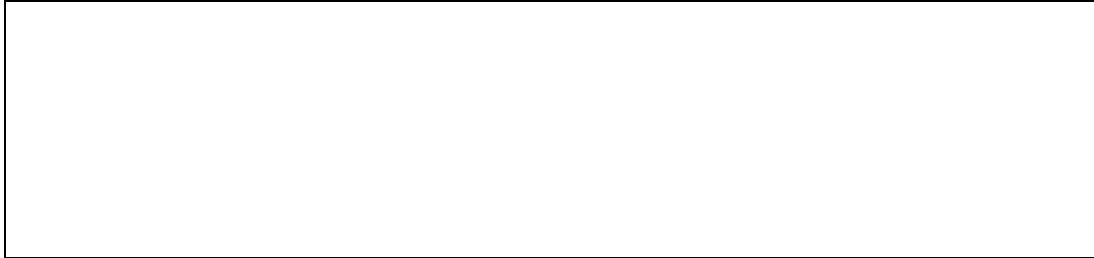

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The show is run in accordance with the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain Rules for 2025.
2. No responsibility will be accepted by the Organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors and/or Riders or their Horses. Entries are accepted on this basis.
3. Classes will not run ahead of schedule, but large entries might cause some classes to over-run.
4. A Parent/Guardian must attend the Show to accompany any child under 18 years of age.
5. Horses need to be registered with SHB(GB) to compete in SHB(GB) affiliated classes and all owners and riders must be current members of SHB(GB) to compete in SHB(GB) affiliated classes – see note 6 below for requirements in relation to competing in qualifying classes for the Royal International Horse Show.

6. **RIHS RIDDEN AND WORKING HUNTER QUALIFIERS:**

Classes **4 – 7, 8-11, 13 & 20-21** are qualifiers for The Agria Royal International Horse Show. In classes 4 – 7 inclusive and class 13, the two highest placed horses will qualify, no horse lower than 2nd will qualify. In class 10 the two highest placed smalls and the 2 highest placed lightweights will qualify. In class 11, the 2 highest placed middleweights and the 2 highest placed heavyweights will qualify. In classes 20 & 21 the two highest placed horses from each class will go through to the Working Hunter Championship – C4 and all these four horses will qualify for RIHS if they have not already done so. RIHS Qualification will not pass down the line beyond the aforementioned placings. Entry Fee = £36.00 (includes of £12.00 RIHS Levy).

Only horses registered with SHB (GB) and who are also registered on the current year's Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter in Qualifying Classes for RIHS Ridden and Working Hunter Championships and the Show Hunter Registration Number must be quoted on entries. Any horse that is entered for a Qualifying Class without first being on the Show Hunter Register cannot subsequently be registered and therefore will not be eligible for entry in that class on the day and will be disqualified if forward.

DAY TICKETS - Competitors may compete on a day ticket £42 (and may have a maximum of two Day Tickets per season (£42)). Each day ticket is valid for one show and it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration/over-stamp for that show. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration/ over-stamp must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

7. **SHB(GB) National Hunter Supreme Championship Show**

In classes 4-7 inclusive and class 13, the first three horses will qualify for the SHB(GB) Supreme Open Championship to be held at the SHB(GB) National Hunter Supreme Championship Show 2025.

8. **RIHS British Horse Feeds and IDHS (GB) Ridden Championship Series**

This show is a qualifier for the British Horse Feeds and IDHS (GB) Ridden Championship Series. The 2 highest-placed horses (not already qualified) from Classes 8 and 9 will qualify for the final to be held at the Agria Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead on July 26th 2025. Qualification can be passed to 3rd place if the highest placed horses have already qualified and if in the opinion of the Judges, the exhibit is of sufficient quality. Horses can only qualify once, irrespective of the number of shows entered.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Purebred Irish Draught Horses must be registered with or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB). Purebred stallions must be the progeny of a graded mare (ID Class 1, ID Class 2, RID, AID, or Supplementary Grade Up) by an ID Class 1, Class 2, RID(GB) stallion and be inspected or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as ID Class1, Class 2 or RID(GB).

Owners of Pure-Bred Irish Draught horses must be FULL members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB).

Class 8 Ridden Purebred Irish Draught – first 2 to qualify

- Irish Draught Sport Horses & (ID Part-Bred) Horses, including Stallions must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. Owners of IDSH (ID Part-Bred) horses must be FULL members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB).

Class 9 Ridden Irish Draught Sport Horse (ID Part-Bred) – first 2 to qualify

All horses must be in the correct ownership and must be 4 years and over and 153cm (15hh) or over.

Open to mares, stallions and geldings 4 years and over, registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

N.B. Stallions MUST be ridden and handled by an experienced person over the age of 18 and identified by a red, white and blue tail ribbon.

9. **NOVICE CLASSES:**

Novice Classes 1, 3 & 17 are open to horses four years old and over exceeding 148cm, not having won three **affiliated** Novice classes **or three affiliated Open classes** (excepting Working and Ladies classes) before 1st January in the current year, OR, not having been placed 1-9 in ANY CLASS (excepting Working, Ladies and Search for a Star) at The Royal International Horse Show OR Horse of the Year Show before 1st January in the current year.

NOVICE WORKING CLASSES

*Mare, gelding or stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail), four years old and over, exceeding 148cms, not having won three **affiliated** Novice working classes **or three affiliated Open working classes** before 1st January in the current year, OR, not having been placed 1-9 in ANY WORKING HUNTER CLASS at Royal International Horse Show or Horse of the Year Show before 1st January in the current year .*

Horses that have more than 5 BE points or 200 BS points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1st January in the current year are not eligible to compete in novice working classes.

A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle.

10. **SMALL HUNTER** Animals in ridden height restricted classes WILL NOT be required to be in possession of a JMB Height Certificate or verification of measurement to compete in RIHS or HOYS Qualifiers. However, qualifying animals will need to be measured WITHIN 28 DAYS OF QUALIFICATION OR BEFORE THE FINAL, WHICHEVER IS SOONER. The valid JMB full height certificate or a valid JMB annual height certificate must be submitted to the SHB(GB) office on receipt from the JMB and prior to competing at RIHS or HOYS. There are NO exceptions to this rule.

11. The Organisers reserve the right to make alterations to the published timetable, cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend the conditions of any class at their absolute discretion. If entries are large, it may be necessary to arrange preliminary judging or split classes as may be deemed appropriate.

11. **REFUND OF ENTRIES:**

A maximum of 50% of an entry fee will be refunded on submission of a signed & stamped official veterinary certificate lodged in the SHB(GB) Edenbridge office no later than 24 hours from the close of the show. There will be no refunds for clashes or missed classes.

12. **STABLING:**

Overnight stabling is available and MUST be booked direct with Addington Equestrian and not via the SHB(GB) office or with your entry, please go to [Entry Equipe](#) to book your stables.

13. **DOPE TESTING:**
Please note all Horses on the Showground may be required to be dope tested and testing will be via blood or urine samples.

14. **DOGS:**
Dogs must be kept on **leads at all times**. Dogs are not allowed in the main building, indoor arenas or indoor arena seating areas or cafeteria.

15. **OBJECTIONS:**
Objections or complaints of any kind must be made in writing and signed (no anonymous objections or complaints will be actioned) and submitted to the Show Secretary within 1 hour of the close of the judging of the class concerned, accompanied by a deposit of £250 which will be forfeited if the objection or complaint should prove to be frivolous.

16. **LATE ENTRIES:**
Entries close on Thursday 17th April 2025.
Late entries taken after 17th April 2025 via Entrymaster at 50% extra.
Entries taken on the day via Entrymaster at 100% extra.

17. **First Aid:**
A £5 First Aid fee will be levied for each Rider/Handler.
