# SHB(GB) 5 STAGE CLINICAL EXAMINATION

# **PRE STALLION GRADING**

#### **<u>Purpose of examination</u>** :

'To assess suitability for presentation to SHB(GB) for Stallion Grading'

## **Veterinary Surgeon :**

The Veterinary Surgeon carrying out the examination must be in full time equine clinical work and have been qualified at least 5 years.

## **Examination**:

To be performed within 6 weeks of the closing date of entries for the Stallion Grading.

To be carried out and documented on VDS Certificate of Veterinary Examination of a Horse prior to presentation for Breed Society Grading.

To be reported on Veterinary Defence Society report form, electronically and to be submitted to SHB(GB) <u>laura@sporthorsegb.co.uk</u> before the closing date of entries for the Stallion Grading and copy to be retained by the examining veterinarian.

# NO PRE PURCHASE EXAMINATION FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

The following to be noted on the report form :

All asymmetries, including feet.

Any stereotypies, allergies or vices.

**Inspiratory noise :** 

If an inspiratory noise is audible, the stallion then to have standing endoscopy directly after exercise.

Laryngeal hemiplegia grade 1 suitable for grading

Laryngeal Hemiplegia grade 4 not suitable for grading

Laryngeal hemiplegia grades 2 & 3 overground endoscopy to be performed in the strongly exercised horse. Video recordings to be submitted to SHB(GB) for independent specialist opinion , the specialist being nominated by SHB(GB).

No blood samples for non normal nutrients required.

No X rays required.

#### At the Stallion Grading :

A SHB(GB) Official Veterinarian will be present to advise the Stallion Grading Judges in the event of any veterinary issues.

Standing endoscopy may be performed after exercise and overground endoscopy requested.

Blood sampling for non normal nutrients may be required.

All veterinary fees at Stallion Grading to be met by the Stallion Owner.
